

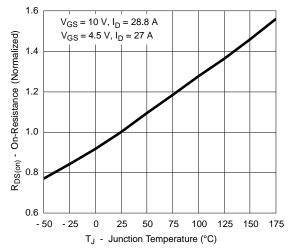






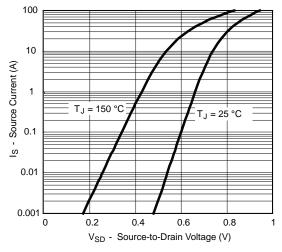

On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature




 $R_{DS(on)}$  vs.  $V_{GS}$  vs. Temperature



Forward Diode Voltage vs. Temperature




Threshold Voltage







Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Case

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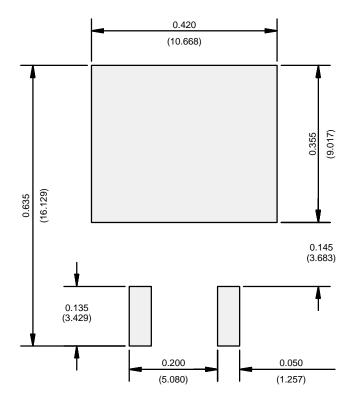
